STUDIO RULES

- No one is allowed in the studios without staff supervision
- Please no street shoes on studio floors
- No food, drink, or gum in the studios (water bottles are fine!)
- Cell phones must be silenced or turned off while in class
- Pull hair back away from your face for class
- Visit the restroom BEFORE class starts

Parents: Don't forget to write your student's name inside their shoes, dance bags, etc.

Please do not leave children unattended in the lobby. For their safety, do not let children climb or play on the benches or chairs in the lobby.

SHOE REQUIREMENTS

The required shoes for each class genre are provided below. Superstars Performing Arts offers these shoes for purchase at the reception desk. Orders will be placed the first several weeks, and periodically throughout the season as necessary. We also begin placing regular orders in early Spring as the studio gears up for recital.

CLASS SIZES ARE LIMITED

Please bear with us as we evaluate your child's class. We want to make sure your child is in the appropriate level to ensure they will benefit from their class. We believe in quality over quantity, and prove it by limiting our class sizes, here at the Superstars we do our best to limit our classes to around 18 students or less, and around 13 or less for Preschool classes. Staff will be monitoring classes the first few weeks. If it is determined that a different class would be better suited for your child, we will contact you.

CLOSED CLASSES

We have seen quite an increase in our enrollment, and interest in students who want to join our Superstars family! We are so grateful, and are doing our best to evaluate class sizes and exploring options for adding classes, if necessary. If you know of anyone who wants to join us, but were unable to register due to closed classes, please have them contact us! We want to ensure that every student who wants to join has a chance to do so.



CHRISTMAS SHOW

This year's Christmas show is scheduled for <u>Sunday, December 16, 2018 at 1:30pm in the Norwalk High</u> <u>School Auditorium</u>. Only our younger students (*typically those students 4th grade and younger*) will participate in the Christmas Show. Additional details and a list of classes that will participate in the show will be communicated late October. The show is very casual and typically lasts about one hour.

RECITAL 2019

This year's recital is scheduled for Saturday, June 1, 2019. Rehearsal for all non-competition classes scheduled for Friday, May 31 at the Norwalk High School Auditorium. Competition Teams are scheduled to rehearse on Thursday, May 30. Recital break outs and recital times will be posted closer to the recital date. Recital pictures are scheduled for Saturday, April 27. Competition Dance & select dance classes will be taken Thursday, April 25, and Competition Baton will be taken Friday, April 26. Recital pictures will be taken at the studio.

Costume-Measuring Week

All classes will be measured for recital costumes the week of November 5-8. We encourage students to wear form fitting clothes during costume measuring week to ensure correct measurements.

Thanksgiving Break

The studio will be closed Tues., Nov. 20 through Sun., Nov. 25 for Thanksgiving. Classes WILL be held on Mon., Nov. 19 to make-up for Labor Day.
