DROP/CHANGE POLICY

LAST DAY TO DROP/ADD A CLASS IS NOVEMBER 1

If you choose to drop a class or discontinue classes with the Superstars, you must contact the studio via email by the 15th of the month. Informing the teacher or failure to report to class does not constitute a drop. If a class is dropped after the 15th of the month, the account will be charged for the following month's tuition and any applicable fees. Accounts will continue to be charged until written communication is provided to the directors.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENTS

The studio will process automatic payments at the beginning of each month. The first automatic payment of the year was effective on **Saturday, October 1**st. Please look at your checking or credit card account and verify that this transaction took place. If it did not, please contact the office, as something is incorrect with your account. If you need help updating or setting up your payment method, please contact the studio. We offer automatic payment plans for your convenience, however, it is your responsibility to make sure your bill is paid. Thank you!



STUDIO SHIRT SIZE VERIFICATION

We will be ordering studio shirts for this season very soon! We want to make sure each student receives the correct size shirt, so we ask that you either check your registration portal or confirm with the receptionist that the shirt size we have on file is up-to-date. Shirts will be ordered at the beginning of November, so whatever size we have on file as of **November 1**st will be the size we order. We are unable to offer exchanges due to incorrect/outdated student information.

COSTUME FEES

In addition to monthly tuition, a Costume Deposit of \$40 per costume will be added to your account on **November 1**st. Remaining Costume Balances will be processed on **December 1**st. Please note: all costume fees are non-refundable. If your student drops his/her class after either costume charge has been processed, you will not be reimbursed for that charge.

SHOES

In order to ensure a uniform look on stage, the majority of our classes are required to purchase shoes through the studio. As a reminder, shoe orders must be placed at our 810 Main Street location. Front desk staff will be available to help with shoe sizing/ordering Monday-Thursday evening during regular class hours. When ordering shoes, please bring your student along to ensure a proper fit. Once shipments are received, shoes will be delivered to the location of your student's class.


